APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED PRIOR TO CLOSING TIME ON MARCH 22, 2019. ANY APPLICATION THAT IS INCOMPLETE, NOT MEETING THE MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS OR MISSING REQUIRED DOCUMENTS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.

Official Rules and Required Documents

Winners will be selected solely on the basis of the following criteria:

1. Student must be a resident of the State of Florida for at least 12 consecutive months prior to application deadline.
2. Applicant must be a high school senior graduating by the end of the current school year and planning to attend an accredited college, university or post-secondary institution of higher learning for the coming school year.
3. Either the student or their parent/legal guardian must have been a primary member of SFEFCU with an active (non-dormant) account opened on or before April 1, 2018. A dormant account is an account that has been inactive for more than 11 months. Dormant accounts must be reactivated by completing a transaction (deposit, withdrawal or transfer) or by calling the Member Contact Center at 305-270-5250. Dormant accounts must be brought to active status prior to the deadline, March 22, 2019 to be considered eligible.
4. By March 22, 2019, the student must have opened their own SFEFCU account (as a primary member) and the account must be active.

The completed application **MUST** be submitted with the following required documents:

1. Student must present a fully completed and signed application along with a **copy** of the student's official birth certificate. Birth cards are not acceptable. If the student has a legal guardian, an official letter of guardianship is required.
2. Student must present a current OFFICIAL form* from the student's high school confirming that the student is presently attending and meeting graduation requirements, and will graduate with a standard diploma by the end of the current school year. **NO TRANSCRIPTS PLEASE.**
 - The OFFICIAL form or Confirmation must be on school letterhead signed in ink or stamped by the school's CAP Advisor or Guidance Counselor. **Forms must be signed in ink or stamped; otherwise, they will not be accepted.** The high school must be located in Florida and accredited with the State of Florida/SACS.

Selection of Scholarship Winners

A random drawing for the winners will be held after the application deadline in the presence of at least one Director, the Scholarship Committee and the Credit Union's attorney or CPA.

The fifteen winners will be notified by telephone and/or mail and are expected to attend the 2019 Scholarship Presentation Ceremony on Thursday, May 23, 2019.

Names of the winners will be posted online at www.sfefcu.org/undergraduatescholarship no later than close of business on May 8, 2019. **Notification will only be given to scholarship winners. Non-selected applicants will not be notified.**

Photographs of the winners will be taken by the Credit Union for display on a plaque in each Credit Union office, for use in Credit Union publications and release to the news media.

As the purchaser, SFEFCU remains the account owner of the Prepaid Tuition Plan.

Scholarships awarded to students that fail to meet the eligibility requirements as specified will be reclaimed by the Credit Union. **Any unused portion of an awarded HOS Scholarship will be reclaimed by SFEFCU if it has not been used within seven (7) years from the date of issuance.**
